Aoba-Japan International School and Nadia NPO to hold the **"Nadia International Soccer Friendly Cup"** (June 16th to 18th) as a good opportunity to create friendship with Tohoku kids

Aoba-Japan International School (A-JIS) Aoba-Japan Extension (AJE) and Nadia NPO will hold an event, the "Nadia International Friendship Soccer Cup," on June 16th to 18th, 2017, at the A-JIS Hikarigaoka campus and Harunokaze Elementary School. The event aims to provide an opportunity for kids from Tohoku to create friendship with representatives from the international community in Tokyo through sports and community building. This year is the 3rd to hold this event and the number of participants has been increasing year by year.

Nadia is an incorporated non-profit organization that was established in March 2011 by a group of international and Japanese volunteers in reaction to the Tohoku Earthquake of 3/11 and the disastrous consequences that followed. As an international volunteer group focusing on helping the recovery of devastated areas, they have been engaged in a variety of support and recovery efforts since then.

This event will be held for the purpose of providing an opportunity for kids from Tohoku affected areas, Tokyo, and from abroad to come together, compete together in a friendly soccer tournament and build friendship through activities of the 3 day event. The event will also help raise awareness of participating Tokyo residents and international community about those directly affected by the 3/11/2011 earthquake and aftermath from Iwate, Miyagi, and Fukushima.

We will have 10 teams in total, 2 teams from Tohoku, 1 from Iwate, and the others are teams from Tokyo-based international schools. Kids from Tohoku will stay at Aoba-Japan International School during this event, and each Tokyo team will support a Tohoku team throughout the weekend. Volunteers from our sponsors' organizations will also be supporting the event.
