New Banquet Rooms

Designed by the award-winning designer, Yukio Hashimoto, the new banquet rooms' design concept, 'Wind of Light', reflects the simple natural beauty of fresh breezes, rippling waves and sparkling lights. The design elements were inspired by the hotel's iconic urban resort location, the scenic Tokyo Bay and panoramic skies. The stunning banquet rooms are furnished with state-of-the-art lighting and audio-visual equipment such as moving lights (72 lights, 2 kinds), pre-programmed LED color lighting, high-quality digital video projectors and high-power audio systems. ■ **'soara'**: The largest ballroom in the hotel, 'soara' accommodates up to approximately 1,400 guests. Taken from the inspirational word 'soaring', this new name reflects the soothing and relaxing ambience of the new banquet hall interiors as well as Hilton's legendary flawless execution of events and elevation of any social or business event creating a unique and memorable experience.

■ **'G' and 'S'**: Two medium-size event rooms. Single-letter names highlight the new distinctive modern interiors: 'G' is coined from precious 'Gold', while 'S' is coined from 'Silver', with both names subtly suggesting their respective colors.

■ **'azur', 'cyan', 'evo', 'ami', 'neo', 'vio' and 'arc*'**: Eight intimate-scaled event rooms are named after natural elements: 'azur' and 'cyan' reflect the scenic blue ocean and clear skies that surround the resort hotel, while 'evo', 'ami', 'neo', 'vio', and 'arc' are coined from the words 'evolution', 'amiable', 'new', 'vio' (meaning 'Life' in Greek), and 'arc' (taken after the English word) respectively.

* 2 event rooms will be named 'arc'.
